



Sunday Service Reopening Guidelines & Procedures

In order to provide a safe and healthy environment for everyone attending, we ask each person to observe the COVID-19 guidelines listed below.

1. Before coming to the service, please self-screen for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.

This means:

- Taking your temperature. If you, or someone in your home, has a temperature of 100.4, please stay home. Anyone showing signs or symptoms of illness, even cold symptoms unrelated to COVID-19, will kindly be asked to leave the facility and return home. Please know this is for the good of our church community and not a punishment.
- Any person with a household member who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or with symptoms of COVID-19, may not attend the service.

2. Maintain a minimum six-foot separation between those outside your family and yourself in all interaction and in all places. Within the building, you'll see we have included stickers on the floor, single and double arrows to help maintain a six-foot separation.
3. Volunteers and elders can assist with seating in the sanctuary, or balcony, and are available to answer any questions if necessary.
4. Children's Sunday morning programming is suspended at this time. All services are "family style" with kids and youth sitting with their families throughout the service.
5. Restrooms are to be used by only 2 people at a time. You'll see signage on the outside door indicating whether the restroom is in use or available. When done using the restroom, use a disinfectant wipe to wipe down the surface, sink handle, stall handle, toilet handle and door handle. Deposit used wipe in the garbage can with outside the door when done.

6. When washing hands, wash for at least 20 seconds. Signs encouraging hand washing can be seen throughout the facility.
7. Face masks are required and must be worn at all times during the service. If you don't have a mask, or forget one, we have disposable masks available in the lobby. If you choose not to wear a mask, you will kindly be asked to watch the service online from your home. In compliance with Washington State guidelines, face masks are also required outside the facility.
8. Communion will be available near the check-in table at the entrance of the church for pick up by each individual and family. The common juice and wafer will be individually packed. We will observe a time of communion meditation and prayer, but ask that you partake of the communion emblems outside of the building (preferably at your home).
9. Tithes and offerings can be deposited in the drop box at the check-in desk in the lobby. Our preferred method for giving is through automatic bank draft, via the WSCC App or online at: westseattlechristian.gives
10. Contactless hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the facility, along with pump bottles in various locations. We encourage you to use them liberally.
11. Tissues can be found in each restroom and in the window shelves at the back of the worship center.
12. We are currently not offering coffee or snacks. You are welcome to bring snacks (especially for your kids), but please do your best to wear masks when not consuming them.
13. Connection cards can be found on the Connection Desk in the lobby and can be placed in the drop box located there.
14. We have stopped the use of bulletins for the foreseeable future and have gone completely paperless with most communications. Please see our website, sign up for the weekly church newsletter, and download the WSCC app to stay in the loop.
